- I will always ask if I get lost on the Internet

E-Safety Rules for Key Stage 2

- I will only use the Internet with permission
- I will tell an adult if I see anything I am uncomfortable with
- I will think carefully about whom I am emailing and what I am saying
- I will only send and post messages and comments that are polite, friendly and respectful
- I will never give out personal information or passwords and if I find out another person's password I will tell the teacher
- I will ask an adult before I open any emails sent by anyone I don't know
- I will never arrange to meet anyone new that I have only chatted with online.
