English



We are reading 'Zoo' by Anthony Browne. We will write for a range of purposes, including poems, non-chronological texts and letter writing. We will be focussing on subordinating clauses and tenses in our grammar work.

Maths

This term, we will be moving onto fractions, time, money, measurement and statistics. We will be continually practising the 4 operations we have previously covered.

There will continue to be a real focus on arithmetic and fluency within a range of operations, along with a secure knowledge of times tables. Your support with this would be greatly appreciated and will undoubtedly help your child feel confident this term.



Explore, Dream, Discover

In Geography, we will be answering the question 'What are the human and physical landmarks of Wales and Northern Ireland?'

In History, we will be looking at the changes in Britain throughout the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age.

During our Science lessons, we will be exploring light.

In RE, we will be finishing our Judaism question (How do festivals and family life show what matters to a Jew?), before moving on to look at Christianity.

We will continue to have two PE sessions a week! These will be on a Tuesday and a Friday. Please ensure that your child comes to school in their full P.E kit on their set P.E days.

Reading and Homework expectations

Spelling - On a weekly basis, your child will be taught new spelling patterns and will be given key words to learn. Although time will be given at the start of each day for pupils to practise these at school, we would also strongly encourage pupils to practise them at home. To facilitate this, weekly spelling lists will be posted on CLASS DOJO every week, which the pupils will be tested on every week.

Homework – The focus for homework will remain on times tables. Again, like spellings, these will be posted on CLASS DOJO every week. Please ensure completed homework is returned every Monday.
